





1028 Total Number of Unduplicated Child Victims Seen in 2015




Ethnicity of Child Victims








County of Jurisdiction

Children Seen by Location










Reason for Referral

Age of Alleged Perpetrator









Location of Abuse



Total Number of Unduplicated Child Victims Seen


